# County and Circuit Hotline

- To find out when to come for a drug test, you will call the Hotline at (772) 462-6400 or (863) 763-1245 after 7:00<sup>PM</sup> every evening and listen for your birth month to be announced.
- Weekend and holiday testing messages are left on the hotline at 6:00<sup>AM</sup>.
- On Sunday you must call twice; at 6:00<sup>AM</sup> and at 7:00<sup>PM</sup> for Monday's numbers.
- Please continue to call the hotline if the message is not left on time. Phone line problems eventually clear up; you cannot use that as an excuse to miss a test.
- The numbers are also online at [slcdrugtesting.com](http://slcdrugtesting.com).
- You may use either the Fort Pierce, Lyngate or Okeechobee Labs interchangeably. No additional fees will apply.

# Family Court Parents

Parenting children from separate households is never easy but when one parent is suspected of abusing drugs or alcohol, visitation becomes problematic and even dangerous. Parents can use the St Lucie County Drug Lab to test before and after visitation, to ensure drug use is not an issue during visitation.

The testing parent should arrive at the lab as early in the day as possible so the results can be ready the same day (Fort Pierce only). Results can be emailed directly to the other parent and the attorneys if applicable.

If the suspected parent has frequent visitation, using the hotline or Random Texting Program might be a better option. The frequency of testing varies from once per month, twice per month, once per week to multiple times per week. Deadlines to arrive at the lab can be included in the court's order. The lab also has a new Random Texting Program that is very customizable.

All test results are confidential and will only be released to the parents and attorneys.
