FISCAL YEAR 2011-2012 FINAL BUDGET The St. Lucie County Board of County Commissioners, the Fort Pierce Redevelopment Agency and the Council on Aging/Community Transit hosted a groundbreaking ceremony for the Intermodal Transit Facility, located on Avenue D and 8th Street, on Friday, October 8, 2010.

Designed by Edlund Dritenbas Binkley Architects and Associates, this 5,400 square-foot bus terminal and transfer station is a sustainable "green" facility with photovoltaic roof panels and a cistern system for reclaimed water The Intermodal Transit Facility cost \$1.7 million to construct with funding coming from federal stimulus grants, state grants and funding from the Fort Pierce Redevelopment Agency.

The ribbon cutting ceremony was August 17, 2011. The site includes a Park and Ride, bike racks, and a staffed ticket sales booth and is centrally located near the Moore's Creek Linear Park. It is the transfer site for multiple transit routes.


