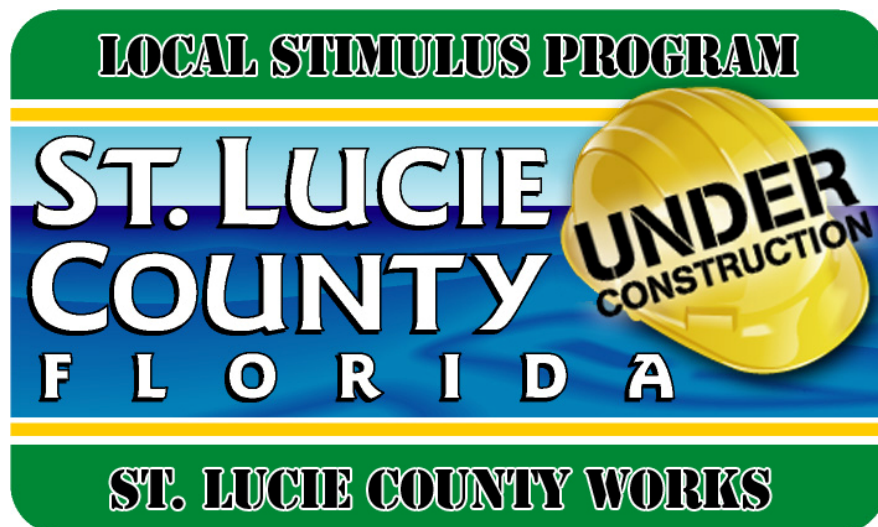

## **Local Economic Stimulus Program**

County Commissioners are taking aggressive steps to improve the local economy, including two new ordinances that will help area businesses and residents. These programs focus on job creation, both short-term and long-term.
