#### **FUND DEFINITIONS:**

An independent fiscal and accounting entity consisting of a self-balancing set of accounts for recording cash and/or other assets together with related liabilities, reserves, and equities segregated for the purpose of carrying on specific activities or attaining certain objectives in accordance with certain defined regulations, restrictions, and limitations.

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These individual funds through which most governmental

functions typically are financed.

001 GENERAL FUND

To account for all financial resources except those required to be accounted for in another fund. Most government entities

maintain a General Fund.

101-199 SPECIAL REVENUE FUNDS

To account for the proceeds of specific revenue sources which

are restricted to expenditures for a specific purpose.

201-299 DEBT SERVICE FUNDS

To account for the accumulation of resources for, and the

payment of general long-term debt principal and interest.

301-399 CAPITAL PROJECT FUNDS

To account for financial resources to be used for the acquisition or construction of major capital projects, which are not financed

by Enterprise or Trust Funds.

PROPRIETARY FUNDS:

These funds are used to account for government activities that

are similar to a business.

401-499 ENTERPRISE FUNDS

To account for the operations that are financed and operated in a manner similar to private business enterprises where the intent of the governing body is that the costs(expenses, including depreciation) of providing goods or services to the general public on a continuing basis be financed or recovered

primarily through user charges.

501-599 INTERNAL SERVICE FUNDS

To account for the financing of goods and services provided by one department or agency or agencies of the governmental unit,

or other governmental units, on a cost-reimbursement basis.

FIDUCIARY FUNDS:

These individual funds are Expendable, Nonexpendable,

Pension and Agency Funds.

601-699 TRUST AND AGENCY FUNDS

To account for assets held by a governmental unit in a trustee

capacity or as an agent for individuals, private organizations,

other governmental units, and/or other funds.


Fund Balance is a term used to express the equity (assets minus liabilities) of governmental fund types and trust funds. The following is an explanation of the changes in the County's fund balance:

- 1. Adjustments in the Court Administrator, Drug Abuse Trust, and Fine & Forfeiture Funds reflect changes as a result of Article V.
- 2. Increase in the Transportation Trust Fund reflects timing of capital projects.
- 3. The Parks MSTU fund was recently established. The increase in fund balance reflects tax proceeds from this new district.
- 4. Reductions in the Tourism Dev 5th Cent reflect anticipated transfers to other funds.
- 5. Reductions in the Erosion District fund balance reflect approximately \$800,000 in grant local match.
- 6. Reductions in the SHIP fund reflect timing of grant expenditures.
- 7. Increase in the Holiday Pines Capital Fund reflects the receipt of loan proceeds.
- 8. Reductions in the capital projects funds and enterprise funds reflect anticipated construction of capital projects.




