

Request for Reconsideration of Access to a Website

The St. Lucie County Library System complies with state and federal laws mandating the use of filtering software in public libraries. Internet filters are software programs that block access to content that is considered inappropriate for viewing in a public place. The Library employs filtering software to protect against the visual depiction of pornography, obscenity, and child pornography. The St. Lucie County Library System is committed to free and equal access to information and will provide unfiltered Internet access for adult users 17 and over upon request for research or other lawful purposes.

No filtering software is totally accurate. Filters may falsely block material that is appropriate in a public library setting or they may fail to block access to illegal or objectionable material. Library patrons may submit a Request for Reconsideration of a Web Site to block or unblock a specific site.
