

VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES IN EDUCATION

Related Volunteer Assignments: Assist with programs including: Adult Education, Youth Education, Youth Camps, and/or Citizen Science.

Purpose: to aid staff in educational endeavors for youth and adults, develop curriculum, collect scientific data and ensure a safe, happy environment for participants

Best for: people who love kids (youth education), have experience in education (adult or youth), experienced at giving instructions and are detail oriented

Required / desired qualifications: public speaking skills, educators, trainers, those interested in sharing nature knowledge, those who'd like to collect data as part of scientific studies

Tasks / duties: presenting program curriculum developed from state standards and requirements, assist lead educator in demonstrations, labs, and/or field excursions. Learn about scientific data collection and reporting.

Training requirements: New Volunteer Orientation, Citizen Science training (program specific), and educators training (program specific).

Reporting: Checking in with Education Coordinator for program schedules, logging hours and metrics through VicNet, submitting Citizen Science data as trained.

Time Commitment: From 4-6 hours a month up to 40 hours a week for youth day camps

Time frame: ongoing, most school programs are weekdays from 10-12 Oct-May, camps typically run Monday-Friday 9am-5pm during summer, spring and winter breaks. Adult programs are typically weekday evenings and Saturdays.
