



RECYCLING PROGRAM OPPORTUNITIES

Related Volunteer Assignments (one or more): recycling program transporter, community ambassador

Purpose: to raise awareness about specialized County recycling programs for plastic wrap and Styrofoam while helping St. Lucie County keep this service viable to all citizens and these materials out of the landfill

Best for: people who are passionate about recycling and like to bring awareness to neighbors, those who are fast paced and don't mind traveling throughout the county

Required / desired qualifications:

For driver: Valid driver's license and vehicle to transport items from drop off locations to county recycling facility

For ambassador: good communication skills, public speaking skills, organizational skills

Tasks / duties (one or more): collect recyclables at various locations on a regular basis and transport to the Solid Waste Facility. Coordinate with Homeowners Associations and other potential collection sites to invite their participation, possibly speaking at HOA or other meetings, writing articles, or other forms of promotion and education

Training requirements: New Volunteer Orientation, Orientation Part 2: Understanding & communicating our land and watershed, Recycling Tactics.

Reporting: Communicating with Community Outreach Coordinator for scheduling and specific needs, logging hours and metrics through VicNet.

Time Commitment: 8-12 hours per month

Time frame: This is a new program and may initially require extra time to develop. Monthly HOA meetings and collections ongoing.
