



ARCHERY VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES

Volunteer Assignments: setting up archery range, equipment maintenance, assist or lead in coaching/teaching archery to participants

Purpose: Archery is a volunteer-led program. Leaders are highly trained and safety is of the utmost importance. The archery program welcomes visitors to the preserve with an opportunity to learn archery and gain new skills in hopes of encouraging them to spend more time outdoors.

Best for: people who enjoy physical activity and are detail and safety oriented

Required / desired qualifications: previous archery training or willingness to participate in training, being safety conscience at all times, must be available Saturday mornings

Tasks / duties: inspect and prepare equipment prior to scheduled archery programs, lead or assist in classroom training prior to field lessons, maintain a safe environment, assist in coaching and range master duties, set up and break down of equipment and range

Training requirements: New Volunteer Orientation, Explore Archery course, USA Archery Level 1 Archery Instructor Certification Course. The Oxbow offers this course for new instructors up to twice per year.

Reporting: Communicating with Education Coordinator and other instructors for scheduling and specific needs, logging hours and metrics through VicNet

Time Commitment: 4-8 hours per month

Time frame: Explore Archery programs take place at the Oxbow Eco-Center from 9am-12pm and Open Range programs from 1pm to 3pm Special programs may be scheduled pending instructor availability.
