Wireless and Telecom Right-of-Way Permit **Specific Conditions**

In accordance with St. Lucie County Ordinance No. 20-001 Section(s) 44-6 & Section 44-11

- 1. Construction Performance Bond and Permanent Performance Bond naming County as obligee must be submitted in the amount as determined by the County Engineer, in full conformance with Section 44-7, and accepted by St. Lucie County, prior to permit issuance.
- 2. Payment of \$150 per pole annually for co-location of facilities on County owned poles must be received prior to permit issuance; Section 44-9 (3).
- 3. All equipment, placed within County Rights-of-Way must be identified as follows: minimum of 3" x 3" plate, plaque, label or any other means of identification, acceptable to County; containing the following information: Registrant Company Name and County Issued Registrant Number, Permit Number and Emergency Contact Phone Number.
- 4. Registrant shall notify St. Lucie County Engineering Division at least 24-hours, but no more than three (3) days in advance of commencing work in the public rights-of-way.
- 5. All Development and Objective Design Standards and Construction Methods for Placement or Maintenance within County Rights-of-Way must be in complete conformance with County Design Regulations and Sections 44-6 through 44-11 of St. Lucie County Ordinance 20-001.
- 6. Registrant and Contractor shall comply with all St. Lucie County Engineering Division's General Conditions and adhere to all applicable federal, state, and local laws.
